

Sir,

For COVID 19 management it is becoming increasingly important to tap all the human resources and build their capacities adequately. This includes both the medical manpower, doctors, nursing personnel, allied health personnel who help managing patients in hospitals; as well as non medical personnel, front line workers, who may be involved in non medical duties such as logistics, surveillance etc. These personnel have to be trained appropriately in the respective areas such as clinical management, infection prevention and control, logistics etc.

- 2. State Institutes of Health and Family Welfare (SIHFWs) are the nodal training institutes of Health in the States. The Directors of such institutes may be nominated as State Nodal Training Officers for COVID 19 management. The SIHFW, in co-ordination with State Health/Medical Education Departments can perform the following kind of tasks:
 - a. Dissemination of all training resources to all concerned personnel (list of training resources available with the Ministry can be seen here ----> https://www.mohfw.gov.in/pdf/
 BASEDOCforRESOURCESrev06042020.pdf)
 - b. Creation of important training resources as appropriate in the State.
 - c. Monitoring of number and quality of trainings. Indicative proforma for the same is attached.
 - d. All other tasks related to training, as requested by the State or NIHFW or Central Government.
- e) 3. It is requested that you may accordingly intimate the Directors of SIHFW's and take appropriate steps to roll out as above mentioned tasks.
